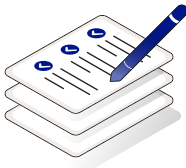


## Legal Aid Ontario (LAO)

LAO can offer general legal information and advice over the phone. If you meet their financial eligibility, LAO may help pay for a lawyer to represent you by issuing you a legal aid certificate. The certificate would confirm that LAO will cover the cost of a private lawyer who accepts legal aid work for a certain number of hours.
